Genesis:

Began when contemplating concepts of identity, in light of Anonymous Resources.

Pursued because aforementioned Title/NameTitle access points were all blank nodes.

Pursued because of engagement with SHARE-VDE and Casalini and the concept of SuperWork.

Intentionally brief.

Intentionally abstracted.

Designed to ensure they are lightweight and maximally (re)usable.

Not the principle Thing requiring cataloger's attention.

Not a starting point or destination for the user, but merely a point of interest along the way.

MARC sources for Hubs say a lot about their ~~composition~~ role.

Hubs

MARC sources for Hubs indicate their role:

They are aggregators, basically.

They provide a point to collect like or related Things.

Hubs

Hubs perform three functions as aggregators,
just as would be expected given their MARC Bib source fields:

- as subjects,
- as related works,
- and as Works in the RDA sense.

Consider their sources: 6XX, 7XX, 1XX+240, respectively.

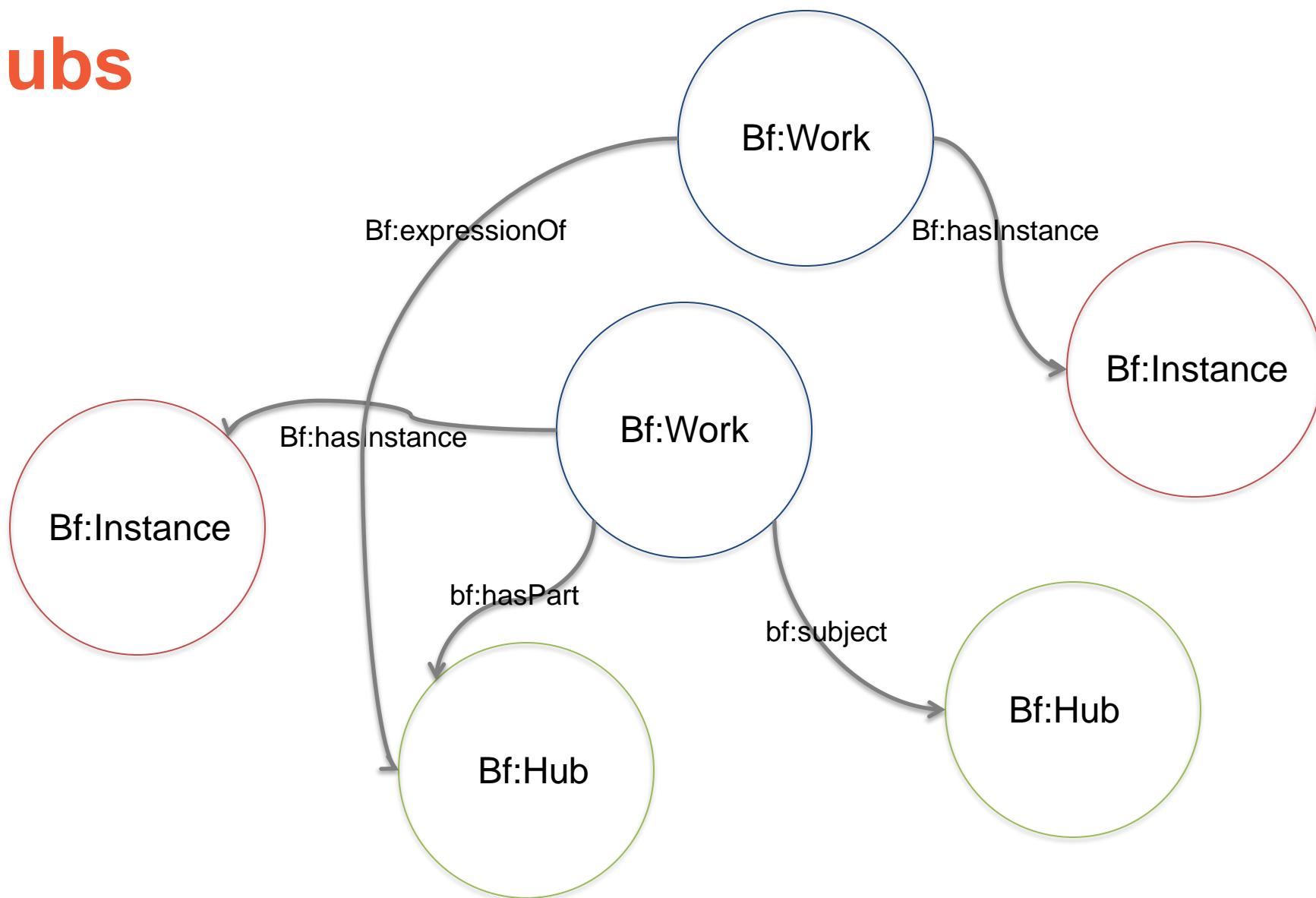
