Metadata silos



Text publishing

- ONIX, THEMA subject codes, ISBN (barcodes), EDI (SAN & GLN), Epub, etc
- ISSN, DOI, EAN barcodes, etc.
- See: https://www.editeur.org/

Music publishing

- DDEX, ISRC, ISWC, RIN, RDR, etc. See: https://ddex.net/
- AV and film publishing
 - EIDR, ISAN, DOI, etc.
 - See: https://www.eidr.org/standards-and-interoperability/

Libraries

MARC, RDA, BibFrame, IFLA LRM, subject and classification standards, etc.

Archives

- ISAD-G, EAD, TEI, ISAAR-CPF, etc.

Metadata silos



- Many silos
- Some crosswalks and common identifiers
 - E.g. ISBN and ISSN critical in automated workflows for libraries
 - Also much re-work of metadata machine and human
- Increasing recognition of the need for high quality metadata
 - End to end supply chain
 - Across supply chains where appropriate
- Initiatives to link through/across supply chains
 - RDA/ONIX Framework for Resource Categorization, 2006
 - Principles of Identification, Linked Content Coalition, 2014
 - Creating a Talent Identifier for the Entertainment Industry, MovieLabs

Metadata control

- Metadata control underpins the business of the global content supply chains
 - Content specific differences between supply chains
 - Content neutral commonalities across supply chains
- Good metadata at the beginning of any supply chain should be re-used and consumed efficiently throughout the supply chain
- Good metadata supports automation, interoperability, efficiency
- Different stages of the supply chain add value according to business need
- Can metadata created to support e-commerce free up library resource and expertise to focus on enhanced discovery and curation?

International Standard Name Identifier (ISO 27729) ISNI's place in the supply chain



- Content neutral standard for name identification
- Resolves name ambiguity
- Unique 16 digit identifier
- Bridge-identifier linking name disambiguation across data silos
- Authors, editors, musicians, actors, artists etc, and also groups, institutions...
- Network of Registration Agencies specialising across multiple sectors
 - Publishers, music, libraries, sound recordings, research, etc.
- Built on contributed data at scale using matching algorithms and human curation



Soundways - Sound Credit



 Sound Credit's free and automated ISNI registration system writes ISNI codes into a digital profile used for crediting music creators









- "assign an ISNI to all creators listed in the Verzeichnis Lieferbarer Bücher (VLB), the books-in-print catalogue used in the German-speaking world"
- "publishers whose books are listed in VLB will be able to register new ISNIs for the creators of their works"



The British Library and ISNI

- Member of ISO 27729 International Standard Name Identifier Committee to draft the standard
- Founding Member of ISNI with the Bibliothèque nationale de France, co-representing the Conference of European National Librarians (CENL)
- Provide QA services to ISNI-IA for build and maintenance of the ISNI database
- Foundational work with data from national library authority files
 - Virtual International Authority File (VIAF)

The British Library as ISNI Registration Agency



- Strategic shift from name disambiguation in the British National Bibliography (BNB) and in our catalogues
- Towards
 - Bridging data silos
 - Identity management for the supply chain
 - Exploiting the potential of the BNB and Cataloguing-in-Publication (CIP) workflows
 - Developing an ISNI Registration Service





The British Library as ISNI Registration Agency



- Principles
 - Embed ISNI in all cataloguing workflows
 - Automate processes as far as possible
 - Engage with the supply chain





The British Library as ISNI Registration Agency



Challenges

- Embedding ISNI in the LC/NACO file
 - Collaboration with Library of Congress and PCC network
- Embedding ISNI in legacy bibliographic data
 - Developing matching algorithms and processes
- Building a Registration Service
 - Online User Portal
- Engagement with the supply chain
 - UK Publishers Interest Group







BL ISNI engagement activities

- Publisher Licensing Services hosted meeting on ISNI for Publishers & Imprints January 2018
- BIC Breakfast March 2018: International Identification for Authors, Publishers & Imprints
 - Included a presentation by the Bibliothèque nationale de France on the integration of ISNI in their CIP workflows



BL ISNI engagement activities

- BL hosted a series of follow up meetings with a **Publisher Interest Group** to explore options for:
 - Using ISNI to identify Imprints and Publishers across the supply chain
 - Explore ways for sharing existing ISNIs for authors in publisher and trade supply chain metadata
 - EDITEUR has provided valued support in cultivating publisher contacts
 - Bibliographic Data Services also a key publishers' liaison as the BL's CIP provider


Embedding ISNIs in the British National Bibliography Graph Matching





 NACO names strings in VIAF correspond to name strings in BNB

 VIAF record cross referenced to pull the appropriate ISNI into BNB



ISNI in bibliographic records



- Investigating population of ISNIs into our back file of bibliographic records
- Matching process with British National Bibliography data


 Publisher provides a name string and associated product(s)

Publisher ID to ISNI Ongoing work



- Further work on improving of match rates
- Bringing NACO up to date in ISNI and re-run publisher files.
- Bringing coverage to 100%
- New ISNI assignment
- Options for filling in gaps
 - Priced batch services
 - CIP feedback loop
 - BL ISNI Service Portal



Embedding ISNI in our Legal Deposit workflow



- Working with our CIP contractor Bibliographic Data Services to integrate into the workflow
 - Developing workflows for inclusion of ISNIs in CIP will implement in 2021
 - BL supplied BDS with a reconciliation file 4.2 million ISNIs & NACO equivalents
 - BL working with ISNI-IA to bring NACO reconciliation up to date and supply on to BDS – 2021
 - BDS then to incorporate ISNIs in their in-house product dataset & CIP workflows
 - BDS examining ISNI membership options to assign new ISNIs
 - Feedback loop to publishers
 - Identity management embedded in supply chain



BL ISNI Registration Portal

- Only ISNI Registration Agencies and ISNI Members can register new ISNIs
 - Using ISNI XML via Atom Pub API
 - Submit CSV files
 - Online web interface for individual submissions
- All requests are processed through ISNI matching algorithms to prevent duplication
- Rich metadata is required to assign new unique ISNIs and assure disambiguation



BL ISNI Registration Portal

- As a Registration Agency the BL can mediate for batch or individual requests
- Processing individual requests is currently a manual process
 - Requests mostly via email
- The BL is developing an online service to allow non-members to request ISNIs directly through a mediated interaction with the ISNI database



BL ISNI Registration Portal

- Three main functions:
 - Search for an existing ISNI
 - Add data to an existing ISNI (no changes or deletions)
 - Register a new ISNI
- User experience online, real time turnaround
- Nominal fee for ISNI registration
- QA support by BL Quality Team

What is ISNI?

ISNI is the ISO certified global standard number for identifying the millions of contributors to creative works and those active in their distribution, including researchers, inventors, writers, artists, visual creators, performers, aggregators, and more. It is a part of a family of international standard identifiers that includes identifiers of works, recordings, products and rights holders in all repertoires, e.g. DOI, ISAN, ISBN, ISRC and ISWC.

ISNI services from the British Library

The British Library offers three services for ISNI users. You can register for a new ISNI, which costs a one-time fee of GBP5.00. You can also search the ISNI database to find and view records, and finally, you can recommend additions or corrections to existing ISNI records. All of these functions require that you are registered for a free British Library user account. Registration takes only a few minutes.
